The Men's division saw David Gibson catch fire on Saturday's round with birdies on his last 5 holes in route to a 3 under par 68. While the field tried its best to catch him on Sunday, David held on to shoot even par 142 for the 2 days and capture his 2nd consecutive Club Championship.
