TEE TIMES: Over the past couple of months, we have noticed an alarming number of no shows, short shows and double bookings. Unfortunately, this deprives other members of the opportunity to play in some of the most sought-after times. Please be respectful to the rest of the membership by being accurate with your tee times with respect to the number of players in your group, making sure someone else in your group did not make a tee time as well, and notifying the Golf Shop when you need to cancel or modify your tee time. With this in mind, we will begin charging for no shows, short shows and double bookings. The member that booked the tee time will be the one charged. I would like to give you an example of how this benefits a member. A member booked a Saturday tee time at 10:42, the earliest we had, but asked if anyone cancelled earlier to please let him know so they could play earlier. Another member who had a tee time at 8:42 had to cancel their tee time on Thursday for Saturday and the Golf Shop staff was able to call the 10:42 tee time and move them to 8:42. This may be you one day! With our membership continuing to grow, it is important that we are able to utilize all available tee space, especially on the weekends. While many of you may be saying, well I don't like being paired up. I have seen it happen in my 35 years as a golf professional that 9 times out of 10 everyone enjoys the experience and most of the time end up playing golf together for a very long time. I mean think about it, we are doing something we love, playing golf!! One more reminder: Tee times on Friday, Saturday and Sunday mornings before 11:00 are for 18 hole players only.

TEE TIMES part 2: If you are playing in the dogfight on Wednesday, Friday, Saturday or Sunday you must call the Golf Shop 48 hours in advance to secure your spot. Please be respectful to the rest of the membership and the Golf Shop staff and let us know you are coming.
