Unfortunately, those pesky frost delays are unavoidable and very hard to predict. Also be sure to check with the Golf Shop staff before using any of the facilities, including the driving range and putting green to make sure they are ready for play. Please be aware and know that the Golden Hills staff is committed to doing our best to keep things running as smooth as possible with as little delay as possible. With frost or excessive moisture, driving a golf cart or even walking on the grass can cause damage to the leaf blades and roots. Please check with the Golf Shop staff for the rules of the day.
